# INTRODUCTION

While the year 2023, which has become a difficult period in which crises and natural disasters occurred one after the other, brought with it great tests for everyone, the earthquakes that occurred in our country and the crisis that started in Gaza on 7th of October gave the whole world a deep shock.

The earthquake, occurred on 6th of February, centered in Kahramanmaraş, and was effective in 11 provinces, unfortunately caused serious loss of lives and property. We, as Yeryüzü Doktorları, were with our earthquake victims from the first day of the earthquake with the services we provided by organizing our volunteers all over Türkiye and forming medical teams.

While we were trying to heal the wounds of the Kahramanmaraş earthquake, we started to witness one of the biggest crises of recent years in Gaza. Tens of thousands of people lost their lives and thousands more were injured in the attacks that hit our agenda on 7th of October. Even though our head office in Gaza was destroyed and we suffered losses, we continued our activities under difficult conditions and were there for the local community.

For the last 23 years, we have been making efforts to relieve suffering in geographies where the crisis has not ended, both with our volunteer medical teams and the health centers we have established. We carry out examinations, treatments and surgeries for those who cannot find a cure due to impossibilities and continue our humanitarian aid activities in many areas such as qurbani operations, water wells, medication and medical equipment supports and psychosocial support. We witness that every story we touch leaves a mark on our own story and continue to grow goodness with all our heart.


We hope to touch many more stories around the world and bring goodness and health to the world.




# 2.2. CORPORATE GOVERNANCE AND ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE

### 2.1.1. Mission and Vision

Having started its activities as an international humanitarian aid organization focused on health, Yeryüzü Doktorları has carried out hundreds of projects so far in more than 54 countries with the support of more than 300 thousand donors and more than 45 thousand volunteers. Having set out initially by organizing short-term health care camps with volunteer medical teams, Yeryüzü Doktorları has started to accomplish longerterm projects in the course of time. As of 2020, it has volunteer medical team services, cataract camps, water well and food support activities, equipment - medication supports and medical training projects, as well as centers providing permanent services in 8 different countries including Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Chad, Palestine, Somalia, Syria, Yemen and Türkiye.

**Mission:** To reach the people in need who are unable to access health care services and help them hold on to life.

**Vision:** To be a leading and competent NGO in the field of medical aid.



### 2.1.2. Principles

Focus on Needs: Services to be provided to people in need are at the center of the decisions and practices of Yeryüzü Doktorları. Attention is paid to quality, quantity and sustainability of the services that are provided without any discrimination based on religion, language, race, gender and geography.

Competence: Yeryüzü Doktorları carries out its medical aid operations with effective and efficient processes and provides quality services. In this respect, it embodies and continuously develops the necessary corporate competencies. It does not take any initiative requiring special knowledge, skill and competence that it does not possess.

Respect for Humanitarian Values: Yeryüzü Doktorları acts based on humanitarian values that form the very essence of helping, such as compassion, sincerity, humility, and trust. It respects the beliefs, cultures and traditions of different geographies and nations.

**Independence:** Yeryüzü Doktorları acts in line with its mission, principles and plans that it has announced in order to spread the goodness. The collaborations that it makes to better serve the beneficiaries do not go beyond this framework.

**Transparency:** Yeryüzü Doktorları transparently discloses what is done with the resources entrusted to it. Services are always conducted in an accountable manner in administrative, financial and legal terms.

# 2.3. MAIN AREAS OF ACTIVITY

# 2.3.1. Emergency Projects

Yeryüzü Doktorları provides emergency treatment services by sending volunteer medical teams to the relevant region in the first place in the event of war and crisis situations as well as natural disasters such as earthquake, flood, fire, etc., and supplies medication and equipment. In line with the identified needs, it supports repair and operation of damaged hospitals or health centers, establishes field hospitals and health centers, and creates mobile health care teams. It develops and implements medium-long term projects so as to replenish the basic needs related to health care infrastructure affected by the crisis situation.



# 2.3.2. Maternal and Child Health Projects

Yeryüzü Doktorları establishes maternal and child health centers and/or improves the existing centers in those regions where mother and child death are observed frequently. These centers provide health care services such as routine checks of pregnant and nursing mothers, performance of healthy deliveries, vaccination of babies, and performance of pediatric examinations. In addition, pregnant or nursing mothers or mothers who have recently given birth are provided with trainings on baby care and reproductive health.

# 2.3.3. Nutrition Health Projects

Within the scope of the nutrition health projects, Yeryüzü Doktorları establishes nutrition health centers and/or supports the existing ones in the regions with frequent hunger problems resulting from drought, poverty, internal disturbances and similar causes. The malnutrition developing especially in children younger than 5 years of age and in pregnant/nursing mothers due to poor nutrition is treated at these centers. In circumstances where medical nutrition treatment cannot be provided, nutritional support is provided through food packages, qurbani meat offered during Eid al-Adha, etc.



# ■ 2.3.4. Eye Health Projects

Yeryüzü Doktorları treats eye diseases, in particular the cataract, and distributes eyeglasses as part of its eye health activities. It also aims to reinforce the local capacity by supporting the health care institutions in the regions where eye health projects are carried out, through activities such as establishment of eye surgery units and training of local health care personnel.



### 2.3.5. Volunteer Medical Team Projects

Yeryüzü Doktorları provides health care services in those regions in need in the fields of both surgical and internal medicine. Accordingly, it organizes short-term camps in the cases where physical facilities are available but there is a lack of specialist physicians and costs of medications and consumables can generally not be covered. In these camps, people whose treatment needs advanced specialist knowledge are examined and operated on by the volunteer medical teams of Yeryüzü Doktorları. Trainings, on the other hand, that are aimed at exchange of information and experience with the local health care professionals during these practices constitute an indispensable part of this entire process.



# 2.3.6. Medical Training Projects

For the purpose of providing sustainable benefit, Yeryüzü Doktorları supports training, certification and specialization programs at associate, undergraduate and graduate levels, and contributes to scientific researches and events by organizing congresses so as to increase the capacity of health care professionals in the countries where the projects and programs are carried out.





# ■ 2.3.7. Psychosocial Support Projects

Yeryüzü Doktorları carries out informative and supportive activities for the local community by conducting screening and examinations with the aim of psychosocial support for the people who have been affected by trauma, disaster and crisis situations. It determines the status of the local mental health system and develops psychosocial support projects in line with the social needs. It also provides psychosocial assistance activities for the NGO staff and volunteer medical teams serving in the field.



# 2.3.8. WASH Projects

Yeryüzü Doktorları drills water wells and restores the infrastructures for clean water access in the regions where there is drought and the infrastructure is insufficient, to prevent the diseases resulting from use of dirty water. It also intervenes in the situations where urgent solutions are needed, by distributing water purification tablets.



# 2.4. NATIONAL AND INTERNATIONAL **COLLABORATIONS**

Yeryüzü Doktorları conducts its projects in coordination and collaboration with international organizations such as the World Health Organization (WHO), United Nations International Children's Emergency Fund (UNICEF), World Food Program (WFP), United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR), United Nations Office for the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs (UN OCHA), European Civil Protection and Humanitarian Aid Operations (ECHO) and German Corporation for International Cooperation (GIZ), and national organizations such as Ministry of Health of the Republic of Türkiye, Ministry of Family, Labor and Social Services of the Republic of Türkiye, Turkish Cooperation and Coordination Agency (TİKA) of the Ministry of Culture and Tourism of the Republic of Türkiye, Disaster and Emergency Management Presidency (AFAD) of the Ministry of Interior of the Republic of Türkiye, Turkish Maarif Foundation (TMV), and Turkish Red Crescent. It also establishes partnerships with local health care authorities, national/international NGOs and universities on project basis in the countries where it carries out activities.

# ■ 3.1.1. Afrin Jindires Refugee Health Center

Yeryüzü Doktorları established Jindires Refugee Health Center in October 2018 for the purpose of providing primary health care services to those refugees living in Muhammediye and Deyr Ballut camps located in Afrin/Jindires region of Syria. The center, which provides health care services in the branches of internal medicine, gynecology, pediatrics, dental health and emergency observation, also provides free medication support. Psychosocial support services also started to be provided in December 2023.

### 3.1.2. Suluk Health Center

The center provides services in the branches of internal medicine, pediatrics, gynecology, dental health, dermatology, emergency observation and ear, nose and throat. In addition to these services, patients are also provided with free medication support.

### ■ 3.1.3. Refugee Health Training Centers Project

Aiming to provide Syrian refugees with primary health care services by integrating them into the Refugee Health Care system of the Ministry of Health of the Republic of Türkiye, the project was commenced in January 2017. Within the scope of the project, carried out with the participation of the Ministry of Health of the Republic of Türkiye and the World Health Organization (WHO), as stakeholders, logistics and human resources support as well as home care and psychosocial support services were provided at the Refugee Health Training Centers located in Gaziantep, Şanlıurfa and Istanbul. The activities, which have been continuing in Istanbul, Gaziantep and Sanliurfa since 2017, were also started in Mersin in February 2022, and the project was terminated on April 30, 2023.

# 3.1.4. İstanbul Altınşehir Community Center Project

Within the scope of the project carried out together with Istanbul Development Agency (ISTKA), psychosocial support activities were organized for disadvantaged individuals at the ages of 4 to 29 living in Istanbul, and activities were organized to improve their life skills and to support their integration with the city and society they live in. Activities were carried out in child-friendly areas and competency development workshops to support the creativity skills of participants and to increase their access to culture, arts, sports, training and social services. The project ended on February 14, 2023.

# ■ 3.1.5. Palestine Program

Following the 2014 Gaza crisis, first, equipment and operation support were provided to two physical therapy and rehabilitation centers serving with limited facilities. In 2015, an office was established in the city center, and a new physical therapy and rehabilitation center was established in Khan Yunis region at the south of Gaza. Later, mobile teams were established, and home care service started to be provided to those in need. The number of home care teams has varied over the years depending on the need in the region. In 2022, activities continued with 4 mobile medical teams and Khan Yunis Physical Therapy and Rehabilitation center. In addition to these services, Middle Area Physical Therapy and Rehabilitation Center also provided healthcare in 2022.

Until October 7, 2023, service was provided with 3 mobile medical teams and Khan Yunis Physical Therapy and Rehabilitation Center, and physical therapy and rehabilitation, medical care and psychological support services were also provided in the region.

On October 7, 2023, one of the biggest crises in its history started in Gaza. During this crisis, which has caused the greatest destruction in recent years and is still ongoing, Yeryüzü Doktorları has continued its services uninterruptedly, regardless of the circumstances. In order to meet the most urgent needs in the region, where the severity of attacks increases day by day and even access to basic needs becomes difficult, 1,700 emergency aid packages, hot meal support for 4,800 people, 6,025 food parcel support, gurbani support for 7,800 people, 200 doctor uniforms to support the healthcare system, 176 hospital kits support, 34,988 medication, medical equipment and consumables aids, and cash support to 135 healthcare professionals working at Kuwait Hospital, were provided in Gaza until 2024. Additionally, aid trucks were prepared in Egypt and delivered aids to Yeryüzü Doktorları team through Rafah Border Gate in Gaza, and aid supplies were also delivered to the charity ship arrived in Gaza from Mersin.

# 3.1.6. Chad Sido Refugee Health Center

100 thousand refugees, who migrated to Chad due to the Central Africa crisis started in the late 2013, have begun to take shelter in the camps established in the southeast of the country. Having first supported a health care center in Bangui, the capital of Central African Republic, during the crisis, Yeryüzü Doktorları started to provide health care services in Chad Doyaba Refugee Camp in July 2014.

In 2016, a new health care center was established in Sido Refugee Camp located in Maro region of Chad, providing shelter for 50 thousand refugees. Within the center, which completed its seventh year at the end of 2023, services such as primary health care, medication support and basic laboratory tests are provided free of charge and on a regular basis. In addition, those in need who have difficulty reaching the center are provided health care services with mobile teams.

Yeryüzü Doktorları has been operating uninterruptedly in Bangladesh since 2017 and provides services in the region such as primary health care service, hygiene kit distribution, qurbani operations, food parcel distribution, iftar organizations and cataract camps.

Thaingkhali Refugee Health Center carries out its operations in the refugee camp no. 19 in Cox's Bazar region of Bangladesh since June 2020. Within the center, primary health care services, laboratory tests and free medication support are provided for refugees.

# ■ 3.1.9. Türkiye-Syria Earthquake (6th of February)

During the earthquakes that occurred on February 6, 2023, centered in Kahramanmaraş and caused great destruction in Syria as well, 50 thousand 783 people in Türkiye and minimum 8 thousand 476 people in Syria lost their lives, and more than 122 thousand people were injured, according to official figures.

The earthquake described as the "Disaster of the Century" affected 11 provinces of Türkiye, including Kahramanmaraş, Hatay, Adıyaman and Malatya.

Having arrived in the region within the first 24 hours of the earthquake with volunteer medical teams from all over Türkiye, Yeryüzü Doktorları delivered humanitarian aid supplies to those in need and started the first interventions. During this period, surgeries were performed for earthquake victims in the fields of orthopedics and gynecology, and earthquake victims who gave birth suddenly or were about to lose their limbs held on to life by means of these interventions. Earthquake victims were provided with examination, treatment and medication support services within the scope of primary health care service provided in tent hospitals set up in the earthquake region. At the same time, to reduce the psychological effects of the earthquake on disaster victims, psychosocial support tents were set and both group and individual interview sessions were held along with activities for children and adults, accompanied by expert psychologists.

In addition to the health care services provided in the earthquake region during Ramadan, food parcels were distributed in tents and container cities to meet the food needs in the region and to support nutrition health. Again, within the scope of qurbani operations carried out in the earthquake region during Eid al-Adha, 527 animals were sacrificed on share basis and delivered to 8 thousand 75 people in the earthquake area.

Having continued its services since the first day of the earthquake, Yeryüzü Doktorları provided primary health care support and psychosocial support services and distributed hygiene kits and food parcels, especially in Kahramanmaraş, Adıyaman, Hatay and Malatya. It also played an active role in the Jindires region of Syria, where the effects of the earthquake were felt, and supported the earthquake victims with its health care services.

### Kahramanmaraş

Having arrived in the region on the first day of the earthquake, Yeryüzü Doktorları set up a tent hospital in Oniki Şubat Stadium during the acute period, and provided the earthquake victims with examination, treatment and medication support services, with volunteer medical teams.

Having continued its activities in Sakarya Container City following start of construction of container cities, Yeryüzü Doktorları provided earthquake victims with health care support through primary health care services. In addition, it aimed to reduce the psychological effects of the earthquake on disaster victims by conducting individual and group interviews within the scope of the psychosocial support activities it provided. Yeryüzü Doktorları carried out instructive and developing activities by organizing child-friendly area activities for children. In addition, it formed mobile medical teams for those in need in the earthquake region, who did not have access to a health support station, and provided earthquake victims in rural areas with services, with these mobile teams. Food parcels and hygiene kits were distributed to those in need at certain periods.

■ Hatay

Adiyaman -

In Hatay, which suffered serious destruction during the earthquake, a tent hospital was first set up during the acute period, and mobile medical teams were sent to rural areas where health care service was needed. At the same time, emergency surgeries were performed in the first weeks by volunteer physicians in hospitals that remained intact.

Having continued their activities in Qatar Container City following the establishment of container cities, Yeryüzü Doktorları teams continued their activities by establishing health support stations and psychosocial support centers, and distributed food parcels and hygiene kits to those in need at regular intervals.

At the health station, which was established in Adıyaman at the first stage with 2 containers, earthquake victims were provided with primary health care service and medication support. In addition to health care services, emergency aid packages were delivered to earthquake victims.

In Vartana Container City, psychosocial support activities and individual and group interviews were carried out, child-friendly area activities were organized, and activities were continued to reduce the effects of the earthquake on children. In this context, movie screening and playing activities were organized to reach children affected by earthquake, and primary health care services were continued at the health support station which was established.

## ■ Malatya

Having carried out its activities in Malatya Sugar Factory during the acute period, Yeryüzü Doktorları provided psychosocial support services for children from the very first moment and held individual and group interviews for earthquake victims suffering from post-traumatic stress disorder.

Later, the psychosocial support station was moved to the Central Malet Container City and served earthquake victims with group interviews, individual interviews, psychoeducation and child-friendly area activities.

Also volunteer medical students provided 120 earthquake victims with health care service in an activity as they named "Health Street".

The psychosocial support area in Malatya was named after Elifnur Şeyma Dalhançer, a Young Doctors Worldwide volunteer who died in the earthquake, and healing of the wounds of earthquake victims in the region continued, by honoring her memory.

In addition, Yeryüzü Doktorları formed mobile medical teams for those in need in the earthquake region, and provided earthquake victims in rural areas with services, with these mobile teams.

# 3.1.10. Emergency Operations

Yeryüzü Doktorları provides emergency treatment services and medication and equipment support, primarily by sending volunteer medical teams in case of war and crisis situations as well as natural disasters such as earthquake, flood, fire, etc., occurred in different geographies in the world. In line with the identified needs, it supports repair and operation of damaged hospitals or health centers, establishes field hospitals and clinics, and forms mobile medical teams. It develops and implements medium-long term projects to replenish the basic needs related to health care infrastructure affected by the crisis. In addition, it works to heal the wounds with services related to meeting the basic needs such as food support, hygiene kits and access to clean water.

# 3.3.6. Qurbani Activities

During the Ramadan period of 2023, 2 thousand 920 food parcels were distributed in a total of 6 countries, including Afghanistan, Benin, Chad, Palestine, Syria and Türkiye (earthquake region), and iftar meals were offered to 8 thousand people in Syria. In addition, 9 thousand 915 packages were distributed for urgent needs in addition to the Ramadan period.

A total of 90 thousand 800 people were reached within the scope of the food aids.







Within the scope of 2023 qurbani activities, 24 thousand 339 animals were sacrificed on a share basis and their meats were distributed to 468 thousand 231 people, in 17 countries.

# 3.4. EYE HEALTH PROJECTS

Yeryüzü Doktorları has carried out eye health projects since 2006 in 20 different countries in total, including Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Chechnya (RF), Ethiopia, Gambia, Cameroon, Kenya, Democratic Republic of Congo, Lebanon, Mali, Mauritania, Niger, Nigeria, Pakistan, Sri Lanka, Somalia, Sudan, Tanzania, Uganda and Yemen.

In addition to the treatment services provided within the scope of the projects, efforts were also made to enhance the local health care services capacity with the activities such as establishment of surgical eye units and training of local healthcare personnel.

In 2023, 25 thousand 420 eye examinations were performed, 3 thousand 591 eye surgeries were performed and a total of 4 thousand 662 eyeglasses were distributed during the activities carried out in 10 different countries, including Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Ethiopia, Gambia, Cameroon, Nigeria, Sri Lanka, Sierra Leone, Somalia and Yemen.

# 4.2. PRESS AND PUBLIC RELATIONS

### 4.2.1. News from Yeryüzü Doktorları

### 20 – 28 January 2023 I Chad **Volunteer Medical Team**

Yeryüzü Doktorları went to N'Djamena, the capital of Chad, with its team of volunteer healthcare professionals, from 20th to 21st of January. It provided examination services in schools and orphanages in the region with 1 pediatrician, 1 ophthalmologist and 1 family physician assigned in the team. Having performed 1,332 examinations within the scope of the activities it carried out for 9 days, the association also supported the patients examined in respect of their referral process and medications.

### 31 January 2023 I Open Your Eyes with Yervûzü Doktorları

According to data of the World Health Organization, 2 billion 200 million people in the world are living with eye diseases. Cataract disease, which is also seen in our country and can only be treated with surgery, consists of 94 million of this figure. This year, Yeryüzü Doktorları launched a campaign named 'Open Your Eyes' to draw attention to cataract disease and vision losses in countries where healthcare facilities are insufficient. Having made a statement on the campaign, Yahyahan Güney (MD), Chairman of the Board of Directors of Yeryüzü Doktorları, stated, "Eye diseases continue to make lives difficult as an important health problem in those geographies in need. This year, we launched a campaign named 'Open Your Eyes' for those in need, who are waiting for us and hoping for their eves to be opened. "You can support our campaign so that more people can access eve health care services and see their beloved ones again.".

### 11 February 2023 I Yervüzü **Doktorlari is Providing Health Care** Services in the Earthquake Region

Having gone into action immediately after the earthquakes that occurred in Kahramanmaraş and affected 11 provinces, Yeryüzü Doktorları provided health care services in the earthquake region with its employees and volunteer medical teams for emergency aid, and distributed medications and supplies. Having made a statement on the earthquake aids in Kahramanmaraş, Ozan Mutlu, CEO of Yeryüzü Doktorları, stated, "Activities of our state and non-governmental organizations are continuing intensively. We, as Yeryüzü Doktorları,

are endeavoring to deliver basic supplies to our citizens in the region affected by the disaster. Our activities in the earthquake region are continuing with a total of 9 teams. At the same time, we are making our plans to meet the medium-long term health care needs in the earthquake region. We can overcome this by fighting with it all together in cooperation. We are waiting for the support and help of all of you.".

### 17 February 2023 I Yeryüzü Doktorlari is Continuing to Heal the Wounds of Earthquake Victims

Having gone into action immediately after the earthquakes that occurred in our country, which were described as the "Disaster of the Century", Yeryüzü Doktorları provided primary health care in Kahramanmaraş, Adıyaman and Hatay with volunteer medical teams. At the same time, the association provided the earthquake victims with emergency interventions and performed surgeries of 29 people in the first three days and continued its activities with its psychosocial support. Having made a statement on the earthquake activities, Ozan Mutlu, CEO of Yeryüzü Doktorları, stated, "We, as Yervüzü Doktorları, have been in the region since the first day of the earthquake. Within the scope of this earthquake that deeply affected all of us, we are working feverishly with our teams to meet the priority needs and to heal the wounds of the community. In this context, we are in our tent hospitals to meet the health care needs of earthquake victims. "We also carry out psychosocial support activities in order to reduce the negative effects caused by the earthquake and to be there for the earthquake victims in this period.".

### 13 March 2023 I Yeryüzü Doktorları is Continuing its Activities in the Earthquake Region

Having moved to the region immediately after the earthquake, Yeryüzü Doktorları provided health care services in the region for a month with its employees and volunteer medical teams from all over Türkiye. Having reached 43 thousand 589 earthquake victims so far, the association continued its activities without interruption. At the same time, with the Friendship tent it erected in Kahramanmaraş when it reached 21 thousand 380 earthquake victims in a month

with examination, treatment, psychosocial and medication support services, it was there for all disaster victims, particularly for children. Likewise, having which erected two health tents in Hatay, Yeryüzü Doktorları provided health care services to 11 thousand 380 earthquake victims, with its volunteer teams, within the scope of examination, surgery and medication support. Within the scope of its services in Adıyaman province, it served 5 thousand 838 people. Having distributed humanitarian aid supplies in the earthquake region simultaneously with health care activities, the association supported 4 thousand 991 earthquake victims by delivering to the region urgent needs such as hygiene kits, food, clothes and blankets.

### 23 March 2023 I Let Your Zakat Be Remedv

This year during Ramadan, Yeryüzü Doktorları reached those in need worldwide, particularly the earthquake victims, with its campaign named "Let Your Zakat Be Remedy". The association continued its primary health care and psychosocial support activities in the tents it erected in Kahramanmaras, Hatay, Adıyaman and Malatya, which were most affected by the earthquake. In addition to the health care services it provided in the earthquake region during Ramadan, it distributed food parcels in order to meet food needs and to support nutrition health, through zakat donations. Having made a statement on the campaign, Consultant Yahyahan Güney (MD), Chairman of the Board of Directors of Yeryüzü Doktorları, stated, "Although this Ramadan will be a bit bittersweet in the earthquake region, we will continue to be there for the earthquake victims with our health care services and food parcels in order to maintain solidarity and cooperation. At the same time, we will also reach those in need waiting for us in distant geographies, with our services. You may also donate to our campaign on our website or give a support of TL 70 by typing "FITRE" and sending it to 7712 from all operators. As every year, let your zakat increase as you share it, and let it be remedy as it increases, this year as well.".

### 10 April 2023 I Yervüzü Doktorları Provided More Than 75 thousand People in the Earthquake Region with Services

Yeryüzü Doktorları reached those in need in the earthquake region within the scope of the campaign named "Let Your Zakat Be Remedy", which it launched this year. It was there for more than 75 thousand earthquake victims in the region. within the scope of the services it has provided since the first day with its employees and volunteer medical teams from all over Türkiye. Having made a statement on the campaign of "Let Your Zakat Be Remedy", Yahyahan Güney (MD), Chairman of the Board of Directors of Yeryüzü Doktorları, stated, "As every year, we are continuing to provide our

aids to those in need during Ramadan, this year as well. We are working with an effort to meet the needs that arose following the earthquakes that occurred in our country and caused tens of thousands of people to lose their lives. "We are continuing to share the blessing of Ramadan in the earthquake region with our Zakat campaign and working to give hope to those in need.".

### 24 May 2023 I Yeryüzü Doktorları: Let the World Heal with Qurbani **Donations**

Yeryüzü Doktorları, which held qurbani activities this year both in the country and in distant geographies, particularly in the earthquake region, with the slogan "Let the World Heal With Qurbani Donations", has determined the domestic sacrificial animal share price as TL 6000 and the international sacrificial animal share price as TL 2600. The association held its 2023 overseas gurbani activities in a total of 16 countries, including Afghanistan, Benin, Chad, Ethiopia, India, Cameroon, Niger, Somalia, Uganda, Tanzania, Palestine, Yemen, Syria, Kazakhstan, Azerbaijan and Kosovo. Having made a statement on the gurbani campaign, Consultant Yahyahan Güney (MD), Chairman of the Board of Directors of Yeryüzü Doktorları, stated, "Within the scope of the operations we carry out in accordance with Islamic procedures and rules, we deliver the valuable sacrificial meat which is entrusted to us, immediately after the sacrificing procedures, to those in need who look forward to accepting these blessings. This year, we are calling out to our donors with our campaign named 'Let the World Heal With Qurbani Donations'. You, too, can make your sacrifice donations to our association which will use the same on your behalf to support those in need".

### 23 June - 4 July 2023 I Eid al-Adha Passed Full of Health in Chad

Yeryüzü Doktorları went to Chad from 23rd of June to 4th of July to carry out gurbani activities and to provide health care services with a volunteer medical team. It performed a total of 652 examinations in the branches of pediatrics and family practice during the Eid al-Adha at its center in Sido, Chad. It conducted the referral process of patients who were examined and provided a total of 767 patients with medication support. While the association delivered sacrificial meat aids to the local community on the one hand, it also provided health care services on the other hand.

### 17 August 2023 I They Have Been Working in the Disaster Areas Since 17th of August

Yeryüzü Doktorları, the foundations of which were laid with the activities of a group of volunteer healthcare professionals during the 17th of August earthquake, is continuing to use the experience it has gained from past to present, in order to remove the traces of the Kahramanmaraş earthquake. Having made a statement on the anniversary of the Marmara Earthquake, Consultant Yahyahan Güney (MD), Chairman of the Board of Directors of Yeryüzü Doktorları, stated, "The destructive effect of the Marmara Earthquake, which occurred 24 vears ago, showed us that humanitarian aid and first aid are of vital importance in the acute period. The experience we gained with our volunteers during the Marmara Earthquake, has today become an inducement for us, as Yeryüzü Doktorları, to be there for tens of thousands of people during the Kahramanmaraş Earthquake. "We are continuing our services in the region with our volunteer doctors, nurses, pharmacists and psychologists in order to heal the wounds of the Kahramanmaraş earthquake.".

#### 5 September 2023 I Türkive's Volunteer Doctors Mobilized for Health

Since the day when it was established, Yeryüzü Doktorları has been providing health care services in both internal and surgical branches in many regions domestically and abroad. Coordinating with its volunteer network from the first seconds of a disaster, the association meets people's health care needs with its Turkish doctors. Yeryüzü Doktorları is sending the volunteer medical teams it draws attention to in its campaign named "Goodness. Health. From Heart To Heart.", both to the earthquake region and to geographies with disadvantages in health. The association, which has been operating for more than 20 years, has provided health care services up until today in 54 countries with its 40 thousand volunteers and more than 250 volunteer medical teams.

Having touched 18 million lives by performing more than 2 million examinations and more than 44 thousand surgeries, Yeryüzü Doktorları aims to continue its activities by expanding them with the campaigns it organizes and the donations it

#### 15 September 2023 I Emergency Aid to Libya from Yervüzü Doktorlari

More than 10 thousand people lost their lives up until today during the flood disaster which occurred following the Daniel storm, which occurred in Libya on 10th of September and caused a great destruction, and the number of missing people approached 20 thousand. Yeryüzü Doktorları

supported the international aid call made by Libya, which experienced the worst flood disaster in its history, with hygiene kits and basic supplies. The association sent support packages containing basic needs such as shampoo, personal hygiene products, diapers and baby food, to the region where the flood disaster affected approximately 2 million people. Having prepared the support packages at the association's head office in Istanbul, the team reached Izmir within hours to go to Libya and departed on board the aid ship under coordination of AFAD.

#### 23-30 September 2023 I Somalia Volunteer Medical Team

Having organized volunteer medical teams in both surgical and internal branches in those regions in need, Yeryüzü Doktorları went to Mogadishu, the capital of Somalia, with a medical team of 7 persons, including 1 ear, nose and throat surgeon, 1 orthopedics surgeon, 1 anesthesiologist, 2 surgical nurses and 2 anesthesia technicians. Having carried out activities in the hospital located in a region struggling with limited resources, the team performed a total of 438 examinations and 42 incurable surgical operations in the fields of orthopedics and ear, nose and throat, for 8 days.

### 12-22 October 2023 I Bangladesh Cataract Operations

Yeryüzü Doktorları, which has been providing services for many years in the center it opened in Cox Bazar Refugee Camp in Bangladesh, performed cataract operations with the participation of physicians of the eye health branch between October 12-22, 2023. Having stayed in the region for 11 days, the team supported hundreds of people in need by performing a total of 1810 eye examinations and 298 cataract surgeries with different partners.

### 13-16 October I 3-5 November 2023 I Youth and Volunteering Management Camp

Yeryüzü Doktorları organized the traditional management camp, for the Young Doctors Worldwide communities, which consist of volunteer students studying at 53 universities in Türkiye, especially in health-related departments, to meet and to conduct annual situation assessments and social events. 147 students attended the camp, which was held at two-week intervals. The management camp, which was prepared with the theme of "Youth and Volunteering", hosted many experts from the academy to the media. This year. interactive studies were carried out with seminars. workshops and field experience sharing held at the Young Doctors Worldwide Management Camps organized in Kefken district as well as Ciftalan Village of Eyüpsultan district of Kocaeli.

### 13 October 2023 I Yeryüzü Doktorları is Delivering Aids in **Gaza Under Difficult Conditions**

Thousands of people lost their lives, and more than 6 thousand people were injured in the attacks that have been continuing in Gaza since 7th of October. Having a physical therapy and rehabilitation center in Gaza since 2015, Yeryüzü Doktorları is healing the wounds of the community struggling to survive under very difficult conditions. While doctors and nurses from the association's team are providing emergency intervention for the injured at Gaza Al-Shifa Hospital and Indonesia Hospital on the one hand, emergency aid packages are being delivered to people in the region on the other hand. Having made an assessment on the situation in Gaza. Consultant Yahyahan Güney (MD), Chairman of the Board of Directors of Yeryüzü Doktorları, stated, "As always, we, as Yeryüzü Doktorları, are continuing to work in Gaza in these difficult days. We hope that the attacks will end as soon as possible and a peaceful environment will be established. Our humanitarian aid activities have been continuing in Palestine, especially in Gaza, since the day we were established as an association.".

# 23 October 2023 I Medical Equipment Support from Yeryüzü Doktorları to Al-Shifa Hospital

Yeryüzü Doktorları is continuing to be there for the local community during the attacks in Gaza since 7th of October. The association supported the critical lack of medical equipment, by sending medical equipment and consumables present in the physiotherapy and rehabilitation center in Gaza to Al-Shifa Hospital, the largest hospital in the region. On 20th of October, having urgently coordinated with the Ministry of Health of Gaza, Yeryüzü Doktorları delivered to Al-Shifa Hospital a total of 13 thousand 837 medical equipment and consumables present in the health center, which are of a nature that can be consumed very quickly, such as bandages, patient diapers, serums, hygienic gels and surgical gloves. Thanks to the great support of its donors, Yeryüzü Doktorları was there for Gaza up until today in terms of both health and humanitarian aid.

## 3 November 2023 I Yeryüzü Doktorları is in Gaza, Where Words

Yeryüzü Doktorları is continuing its activities to respond to the urgent calls for help from the community and doctors of Gaza during the attacks that have become increasingly violent in Gaza since 7th of October. It was there for 19 thousand 406 people, endeavoring to heal the wounds with its doctors and nurses at Al-Shifa

and Indonesia Hospitals and with his entire mobile medical and logistics teams throughout the city. Having endeavored up until today to bolster the morale of the community by distributing supplies for basic needs in AL-Shifa, Indonesia, Al Nasr and Jerusalem hospitals and at different points of the city, the association distributed a total of 750 baby diapers and 100 hygiene and hospital kits. Yeryüzü Doktorları provided health support with its entire team during the attacks that started on 7th of October. It also distributed hot meal as a basic need. Having reached 300 families by sacrificing cattle, the association's team provided food parcels to 1395 families and bread and water support to 900 families.

### 1 December 2023 I Kuwait Hospital in Southern Gaza Has to Serve 1 Million People!

Having provided treatment for the injured in the emergency services of Al-Shifa and Indonesia Hospitals until the blockade which started in northern and central Gaza, Yeryüzü Doktorları evacuated its team because the hospitals became unusable. In Gaza, where 26 hospitals and 47 health centers were out of use due to attacks and lack of fuel and the need for health care increasingly continued, the association started to serve to the community, which was forced to migrate to the south, with its teams in Kuwait Hospital. Having mobilized for health care services in Rafah, where the population has increased from 300 thousand to 1 million, the association is supporting healthcare personnel and their families due to the limited facilities of Kuwait Hospital in the region and the complete collapse of its system. However, due to the decrease in medical equipment and consumables stock, it met the needs of more than 13 thousand people by delivering to Gaza the aid trucks prepared in Egypt through the Rafah Border Gate. Having delivered aid supplies to the charity ship prepared in Mersin, the team will continue its activities for the people of Gaza by supplying supplies through the border gates while providing internal aid at different points of the city.
















# 4.4. Volunteer Management

# ■ 4.5. Young Doctors Worldwide

Young Doctors Worldwide (Young DWW) consists of the volunteers of Yeryüzü Doktorları who receive education in various departments of universities, including in particular the medical specialization areas. Young DWW organize trainings, seminars and conferences and conducts projects on volunteering basis for the purpose of spreading humanitarian aid and social responsibility awareness in university communities.

Young Doctors Worldwide carried out 312 activities in 53 universities throughout 2023.

### 2023 Young DWW Management Camp


Young Doctors Worldwide aims to ensure that the management teams of the communities established in universities are provided with orientation training, that they gain knowledge and awareness in the field of civil society, and that they contribute to their personal development and develop the functioning of the club. In this context, the "Young DWW Management Camp" was organized from 13th to 16th of October and from 3rd to 5th of November with the participation of 147 Young Doctors Worldwide. Training, conferences, interviews and workshops were held within the scope of the camp.

### Kahramanmaraş Earthquake Zone

Following the 6th of February, Kahramanmaraş earthquake, health stations were established in Kahramanmaraş, Hatay and Adıyaman, and psychosocial support activities were started at the same time in Kahramanmaraş, Hatay, Adıyaman and Malatya. In this context, 522 Young Doctors Worldwide volunteers were assigned in health stations and psychosocial support activities in the earthquake region.
